Teaching Specialization: Primary teaching responsibilities at the University of Miami in the undergraduate Bachelor of Public Health (BPH) program, specifically BPH 321: Health Promotion and Disease Prevention. As a Global Health scholar, I also regularly teach a course through the Global Women’s Institute at The George Washington University aimed at international development professionals. This course, called GenderPro, is the first of its kind and is designed to lead to a gender mainstreaming credential for mid-career professionals in international development from the Global South. I also co-developed a graduate-level course in global women’s health at the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing and guest lecture on quantitative methods and health inequalities at the undergraduate and graduate levels. My teaching focuses on the structural drivers of health inequities using an anti-racist, anti-colonial framework.
