Areas of Knowledge (Cognates)

Cognates are groups of courses focused on a specific topic designed to fulfill the University of Miami's General Education Requirements. Cognates arrange courses into three Areas of Knowledge: Arts & Humanities, People & Society, and Science, Technology, Engineering, & Mathematics (STEM). Each cognate is "at least three related courses for at least 9 credits." Students must select three cognates, each with a different Responsible Academic Unit (RAU). Majors and minors can be used to fulfill a cognate in its respective Area of Knowledge.
