Areas of Knowledge (Cognates)

Cognates are groups of courses focused on a specific topic designed to fulfill the University of Miami's General Education Requirements. Cognates arrange courses into three Areas of Knowledge: Arts & Humanities, People & Society, and Science, Technology, Engineering, & Mathematics (STEM). Each cognate is "at least three related courses for at least 9 credits." Students must select three cognates, each with a different Responsible Academic Unit (RAU). Majors and minors can be used to fulfill a cognate in its respective Area of Knowledge. Advanced Writing and Communication Skills

The Advanced Writing and Communication Skills requirement empowers public health students to enroll in courses that will develop their communication skills, both written and verbal, in order to articulate information relating to public health. To fulfill the requirement, students must complete five designated writing-intensive courses and earn a grade of C- or higher in each course. Several public health requirements and/or electives may qualify as writing-intensive courses.

Students must earn a minimum of 120 credits to complete the public health major and earn the BSPH degree.									
Academic Policies									
Grade Point Average: Minimum 2.8 UM and public health GPAs are required to enter the major. If a minimum 2.5 public health GPA is not maintained after completing three major courses, it is recommended that students consider other major options. To graduate, students must earn 2.0 UM and public health GPAs.									
Prerequisites and Courses within the Major: Students must complete the prerequisites, with a grade of C- or higher, in order to enter each course. Students may be dropped from a course if they enroll without adequately completing the proper prerequisites. Students must also complete at least 18 of the 33 credits required of the major in residence at the University of Miami School of Nursing and Health Studies.
